Penny Jahsman is an accomplished bowler with a distinguished career marked by numerous titles, high finishes, and record-breaking performances. Her impressive achievements reflect her skill, consistency, and dedication to the sport over many years.

Tournament Titles and Championships

Penny Jahsman has claimed several major titles throughout her career. She is a two-time champion in both the Tournament Bowlers Association (TBA) and National Independent Tournament (NIT) events. In 1992, she won the Greater Springfield Women's Bowling Association (GSWBA) mixed team championship. She also took first place in the 10th Lilac Tournament (singles) during the 1996-97 season. Additionally, she achieved second-place finishes and multiple top-six placements in the prestigious Women's All-Star Tournament.

In 1997, Jahsman became the first bowler from Massachusetts to be selected for Team USA, further solidifying her status as one of the top bowlers in the country. Her state-level accomplishments include winning the 1990 Massachusetts State Cambridge Championship and securing first place in doubles at the 13th National Amateur Championships of the Massachusetts Tenpin & Candlepin Bowling Association (MTCBA). She also earned a notable 6th place finish in the Women's International Bowling Congress (WIBC) National Tournament Singles and cashed in the last four consecutive WIBC Queens tournaments.

Professional and Regional Success

Penny Jahsman has also made a name for herself on the professional circuit. She is a regional champion with the Overtime Sports Professional Women's Bowling Association (PWBA) and has cashed in multiple PWBA events, with her best national finish being 12th place. She has a high series of 791, which was a record for the GSWBA, and she has achieved over 50 700 series scores in her lifetime.
